

## MBRP Muffler Installation Instructions 1070217

## 700-800 Formula III

**Note:** Local regulations may limit or prohibit modification to your snowmobile's emissions system and/or the sound levels that it generates. It is your responsibility to be aware of restrictions that may apply to your intended use of this product

- 1. Remove springs fastening stock muffler to frame and exhaust pipe. (Set springs safely aside so they can be reused)
- 2. Remove stock muffler.
- 3. Remove stock muffler fastening tab from chain case.
- 4. Re-install the tab on the front most bolt of the aluminum bracket located on the belly pan of the machine.
- 5. Install MBRP muffler, placing its outlet through the stock exit in the belly pan.
- 6. Using the provided stainless steel hardware, cap off the stock exhaust outlets no longer in use.

NOTE: To avoid exhaust leaks use high heat silicone to seal all connections between expansion chambers and muffler. Monitor for leaks during the first 200 miles after your installation and reapply silicone where necessary. We suggest having your local snowmobile mechanic or performance shop install this product.

CAUTION: **<u>DO NOT</u>** touch muffler while snowmobile is running or shortly after it has run, as it may result in personal injury.
