

Removal of Stock Exhaust:

- 1. Remove the seat. **Refer to Figure 1**.
- 2. Remove the rear carrier rack and fender assembly.
 - Remove the plastic rivets, bolts, and nuts holding the assembly to the bike and frame (retain all hardware).
 - Disconnect the wire harness from the tail lights.
 - Remove the winch controller from inner fender (if applicable).
 - Lift off the fender and rack assembly. **Refer to Figure 2.**
- 3. Loosen the band clamp connecting the muffler and mid-pipe to the header pipe.
- 4. Remove the two fasteners at the muffler mounting locations and remove the muffler assembly.

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

- 1. Loosely attach the **4.5**" Clamps to the frame mounts using the provided hardware (Spacer, Washer, Hex Bolt, and Nut).

 Refer to Assembly Diagram on Page 1.
- 2. Slide the **Barrel Clamp** over the expanded end of the **Inlet Pipe** and install it onto the end of the stock header pipe. Do not tighten the **Barrel Clamp** yet.
- 3. Install the **Muffler** through the **4.5**" **Clamps** and onto the end of the **Inlet Pipe**. **Refer to Figure 3.**
- 4. Align the spring tabs on the **Inlet Pipe** and **Muffler**, and attach them using the **Extension Spring.**
- 5. Make any necessary adjustments to the exhaust alignment and then tighten all hardware, **4.5**" **Clamps** and **Barrel Clamp** while ensuring adequate vehicle clearance is maintained (**Refer to Figure 4**).
- 6. Reinstall the rear fender and rack assembly, and then replace the seat.
