

Removal of Stock Exhaust:

1. Loosen and remove the three (3) bolts securing the muffler tail pipe to the muffler body (remove the tail). **Refer to Figure 1.**

2. Loosen the clamp at the front pipe of the stock muffler.

3. Loosen and remove the bolts (2), nuts (2), and washers (2) securing the muffler base to the vehicle mounts. Keep the hardware as it will be reused to mount the new system.

4. Work the stock muffler straight back to free it from the front pipe, and then remove it.

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

1. Place the **Clamp** onto the inlet of the **Muffler Assembly**, then put the **Muffler Assembly** into position and slide the inlet onto the front pipe. Slide the **Muffler Assembly** far enough onto the front pipe that the bracket on the outlet side can be brought to the *inside* of the vehicle mount, and then slide the **Muffler Assembly** back until the mounting holes line up. **Refer to Figure 2.**

2. Replace the stock hardware at each mounting location. Refer to Figure 3.

3. Ensure that the **Muffler Assembly** is properly aligned, and then tighten the **Clamp** on the muffler inlet and fully tighten the stock hardware at both of the mounting locations.

It is recommended that the muffler end cap screws be retightened after the first ride and checked periodically thereafter, tightening if necessary.

In order to maintain optimal performance, the spark arrestor screen should be cleaned after every 30-35 hours of use. The spark arrestor can be accessed by removing the four (4) screws and outlet tip. Retighten the screws to 60in-lbs (6.8Nm) when reassembling. **Refer to Figure 4.**
