


- 1. Apply penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Loosen the nut on the band clamp located behind the particulate filter using a 15mm wrench or socket and remove the tail pipe from the particulate filter.
- 3. Disconnect all exhaust sensors at their connection points to the vehicle.
- 4. Remove the flange connecting the catalytic converter and diesel particulate filter section of the exhaust to the downpipe.
- 5. Remove the exhaust hangers from the isolator mounts and remove the catalytic converter and diesel particulate filter section from the vehicle (this step will require two people, as the stock pipe is heavy). If the sensors are being reused, use caution to avoid damaging them.

Installation of MBRP Competition Exhaust:

- 1. Install the **Front Pipe** by inserting the hanger into the factory isolator mount and connecting the flange to the downpipe using the **7/16**" **Hardware** provided.
- 2. Install the Mid Pipe onto the Front Pipe using the 4" Clamp provided. Do not fully tighten the clamp yet.
- 3. Place the **Hanger Clamp** into the rubber isolator and onto the free end of the **Mid Pipe**. Do not tighten the clamp.
- 4. The Extension Pipe is pre-cut for the 172.4" wheelbase. Cut the Extension Pipe to the appropriate length for the installation vehicle (See Diagram) and install it onto the Mid Pipe.
- Insert the Over-Axle Pipe hangers into the rubber isolators and install the Over-Axle Pipe onto the Extension Pipe using a 4" Clamp.
- Insert the Tail Pipe hanger into the rear rubber isolator and install the Tail Pipe onto the Over-Axle Pipe using a 4" Clamp.



- 7. Align the exhaust as needed and tighten all clamps.
- 8. Re-install the sensors in the provided ports. Attach the pressure sensor bracket using the 3/8" Hardware provided.
