## Removal of stock system:

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Loosen the clamps behind the muffler and remove the tail pipes from the vehicle.
- 3. Loosen the clamps located in front of the muffler and remove it from the vehicle.

## **Installation of MBRP Inc Performance Exhaust:**

- Slide the 2.5"Clamps over the two ends of the factory exhaust and slide the Muffler and Collector Assembly onto the factory exhaust pipes. Now slide the hangers located on the Muffler and Collector Assembly into the rubber insulators.
- 2. Slide the **4" Clamp** over the **Over Axle Pipe** and slide it into the **Muffler and Collector Assembly.** Now slide the hanger located on the **Over Axle Pipe** into the rubber insulator.
- 3. Slide the **4" Clamp** over the **Tail Pipe** and slide it into the **Over Axle Pipe.** Now slide the hanger located on the **Tail Pipe** into the rubber insulator.
- 4. Install the Mirror Polished Tip but do not tighten at this point.
- 5. Align the exhaust for best fit and starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.
- 6. Before starting the vehicle check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
