

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust

1. Install the **Extension Pipe** using a **2** ½" **Clamp** and attaching it to the existing rubber isolator. Leave the clamp loose enough for some adjustment. **Refer to Figure 4**.



2. Slide a 2 1/4" Clamp over the Extension Pipe and then install the Intermediate Pipe to the Extension Pipe. Leave the 2 1/4" Clamp loose enough for adjustment. Refer to Figure 5.

- 3. Slide a 2 ¼" Clamp onto the Intermediate Pipe and then install the Muffler to the Intermediate Pipe. The Muffler hanger fits into the factory rubber insulator. Refer to Figure 7.
- 4. Slide the 2 ½"Clamp over the Tail Pipe and install onto the Muffler. Adjust the Tail Pipe to leave a ½" minimum gap from the bumper fascia. Refer to Figure 8.



6. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
