## **Removal of Stock System:**

- 1. Apply some penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Loosen the nut on the band clamp located behind the particulate filter using a 15mm wrench or socket.

Refer to Figure 1.

3. Cut the exhaust as shown in **Figure 2.** Remove the muffler and tail pipe from the OEM rubber insulators. Remove from the vehicle.

## **Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:**

1. The **Extension Pipe** provided is pre-cut for the crew cab long bed configuration. Cut the **Extension Pipe** to the required length for the vehicle being installed to. **Refer to Figure 3**.



- 2. Slide the 3 ½" Clamp over the 3 ½"to 4" Adapter and install it to the particulate filter. Refer to Figure 4.
- 3. Slide the 4" Clamp onto the end of the 3 ½"to 4" Adapter and install the Extension Pipe. Refer to Figure 4.
- 4. Install the **Tail Pipe** onto the **Extension Pipe** using the **4" Clamp Hanger**. Install the hangers into existing rubber insulators. **Refer to Figure 5**.
- 5. Install the **Exhaust Tip** using a 17mm wrench. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections. **Refer to Figure 6**.
- 6. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
